Valley Stream Recreation at Barrett Park

A QUARTER CENTURY TRADITION THAT GETS BETTER EACH YEAR!

Dear Parents: It's that time again! Time to register your child for the Valley Stream Recreation Department's Barrett Park program. The program begins Wednesday, June 29th and ends Friday, August 12th - daily from 9:00 AM to 12 NOON, weather permitting. Campers must be entering kindergarten in 2016 up to 6th grade. **(Please bring BIRTH CERTIFICATE.)** This is a popular program and space is limited. Registration is held on a first come - first served basis. The program cost is \$225 for the first child and \$100 for each additional child of Village residents; (\$275 for CHSD residents with \$175 for each additional child). Payment is accepted by check, credit/debit or exact cash. (make checks payable to Inc. Village of Valley Stream). The Barrett Park Program is restricted to Village and CHSD residents **ONLY. Children's Swimming Lessons

Swimming lessons are available to children aged 18 months to 12 years old. Red Cross Level I through VI are given for ages 5 to 12 years. "Guppy" classes are for children aged 18 months to 4 years old. Registration will be at the pool. There are 2 sessions offered:

FIRST SESSION: Starts June 27th (Mon./Wed.) June 28th (Tues./Thurs.)
Ends July 20th (Mon./Wed.) June 21st (Tues./Thurs.)
SECOND SESSION: Starts July 25th (Mon./Wed.) July 26th (Tues./Thurs.)
Ends Aug. 17th (Mon./Wed.) Aug. 18th (Tues./Thurs.)

Parent and child must be Pool members.

Each session contains eight (8) lessons. "Guppy" classes require that a parent be in the water with the child. The fee for this wonderful program is just \$40.00 per child per session.

Swim Team

Join an exciting championship caliber team. Become friends with many of your neighbors and get great exercise and competition too! The team practices begin June 13th through mid August and competes in dual meets, class meets, and team championships. Practices are Monday through Friday 5:00-7:00 PM when school is in session and Monday through Friday 8:00-9:30 AM and 5:30-8:30 PM beginning June 27th. Swimmers range in age from 6 through 16 with competitions for 8 & under, 9 & 10, 11 & 12, and 13 & over. Boys and girls are all on the team together however boys compete against boys and girls compete against girls in the above age categories. Enjoy competition, movie nights, car washes, fun trips and the feeling of belonging to a great team. The cost for the team, after pool membership fees, is \$40.00 per person plus equipment and bathing suit.

Come to registration on June 12th between 4 and 6 PM. Be prepared to try out if you have never been on the team. Bring a competitive bathing suit, bathing cap, and goggles. Registration will be held at the Pool.


The Valley Stream Community Band will appear in free outdoor concerts every Tuesday evening at 8:00 PM beginning July 5th and ending August 9th.


Our Mission Statement




