1. Introduction

- 5 1975 purchased by Village - poor condition
- 55 Those who did the restoration work
- 7 5 Basement - heating, soil line, strong room
- 215 Kitchen area part of original building
Pantry, Cooking and laundry, Icebox
- 260 Dining room
Early L- shaped house - later additions
- 300 Foyer
Parquet floor, stained glass
- 310 East room - oldest part
Original fireplace
Original entrance and hall to kitchen area
- 330 Stairs - original treads - 1840
- 350 Northeast room-former bathroom (now kitchen)
Two bedrooms over porch - now removed
rest
Public room - originally a bathroom
- 380 Southeast bedroom - door to former bedroom over porch
Closet
- 400 Head of stairs - Small bedroom and third bathroom -now
Historical Society workrooms
- 420 Westend - Originally two bedrooms - now a meeting room
Odd kinds of lumber used
- 460 Closets in hall- present use
- 470 Third floor - maid's room and original bathroom

- 490 Bell system - bedrooms to kitchen
- 600 Alarm system in West storage room
- 610 Restoration of doorknobs and hardware
- 620 History of ownership from 1920 's
