

# Incorporated Village of Valley Stream - Sanitation Guidelines

Department of Sanitation, 175 Arlington Ave, Hours of Operation: 7AM to 2PM Monday – Friday. Closed on Holidays

**Building Materials** – Homeowners, their agents and/or contractors, are responsible for removing all waste generated from any construction project. This includes, but is not limited to, sheetrock, lumber, pipes, fencing, concrete, tile, flooring, roofing, etc. These materials may be brought to the Department of Public Works facility at 175 Arlington Ave but are subject to a disposal fee.

**Hazardous Waste** – Residents undergoing medical treatments involving radiation should consult with their physician for the proper disposal of biological waste.

**S.T.O.P.** ( Stop Throwing Out Pollutants) is a program that enables residents to safely dispose of hazardous household waste such as chemicals, paints, solvents, fertilizers, antifreeze, batteries, tires, etc. These items should NOT be placed in your regular garbage. Call 516-378-4210 for dates and locations for disposal.

**Special Bulk Pickups** – Special bulk pickups of items such as furniture, carpeting, bookshelves, bathtubs, mattresses, hot water heaters, refrigerators, stoves, washers and dryers, file cabinets, etc. can be arranged by calling the Sanitation Department at 516-825-8108


*\*Please remove doors from refrigerators prior to placing them at the curb\*\**

**Curbside Collection** – Garbage may be placed in trash pails with lids or in sealed garbage bags not to exceed 32 gallons and 50 pounds. Oversized pails or bags that exceed these dimensions will NOT be picked up. Please do NOT place pails, bags, bulk items, grass/leaves, recycling or anything scheduled for collection at the curb prior to 6PM the night before your collection day or after 6AM on your collection day.

**Landscapers** –Landscapers operating within the Incorporated Village of Valley Stream are required to have a village issued permit. They are also required to remove all debris, grass clippings, leaves, etc. from their customers’ homes.

**E-Waste Recycling** – This program enables residents to dispose of electronic equipment in an environmentally safe manner. The program also prohibits municipalities from accepting any electronic equipment as part of your regular garbage pickup. Residents may bring E-waste to our facility at 175 Arlington Ave between the hours of 7AM and 2PM or they can call 516-825-8108 to schedule a special pickup.
